Sewing Instructors Needed

Sewing Instructors are needed to teach Foster Youth. The sewing program sponsored by Arizonans for Children teaches basic sewing to their youth. The program consists of ten lessons that span basic techniques and student graduate to working with simple patterns.

They are asking for instructors to lead or assist in classes. The requirements are:

• Enjoy working with youth ages 8 -17.

• Demonstrate enthusiasm for all sewing techniques.

• Complete volunteer application at <u>www.arizonansforchildren.org</u>


• Agree to background check

• Provide transportation and space to travel with four sewing machines and supplies.

• Allow for a two to three hour commitment for each project

All materials and supplies travel to the foster group homes with instructor.
