AZIE'S BLANKET COVERAGE



Nov 2017

This individual income tax credit is available for cash contributions to Qualifying Charitable Organizations <u>including AZ Blankets 4 Kids, Inc.</u> Starting with the 2013 tax year, taxpayers no longer have to itemize deductions to claim a credit for contributions to a Qualifying Charitable Organization.

Maximum Credit for Any Tax Year:

Single or head of household: \$400 Married filing jointly: \$800 Donation Deadline Beginning in 2016: April 15 (for previous tax year)

How It Works: The state of Arizona offers its taxpayers the opportunity to make contributions to non-profit organizations that *reduce the amount of tax owed* to the state or *increase the amount of the taxpayer's refund*, **dollar-for-dollar**. There is **NO NET COST** to the donor, and deserving individuals around the state benefit.

<u>NOTE TO DONOR</u>: You must have a tax liability for at least the amount of your donation in order to take a tax credit. In other words, if you only owe \$500 to the state of Arizona, you cannot receive \$800 in tax credits.

Complete AZ Form 321 and include it when you file your 2017 State taxes

What is AZ Blankets 4 Kids?

AZ Blankets 4 Kids is an all-volunteer non-profit organization serving children in the Phoenix metropolitan area. Our goal is to provide comforting blankets and quilts to seriously ill and traumatized children in our community.

AZ Blankets 4 Kids welcomes all handmade blankets. Whether you knit, crochet, quilt, hand sew or machine sew -- we welcome your donation. Blankets range in size from 18x18 for preemies at the hospital, to 40x60 for older children. Fabrics should be washable and in child-friendly fabrics and colors.

Once we receive your donation, the blankets are sorted by size and prepared for delivery. See page 8 for Drop Off Locations

Help get your community involved -- schools, sewing and quilting clubs and youth and senior groups are all excellent places to find potential blanket donors
